Dr. Reinhard Brandl has been a member of the German Bundestag since 2009. He represents the constituency of Ingolstadt as a directly elected member of parliament. Since this legislative period, he has been the parliamentary secretary of the CSU in the Bundestag. Previously, he was a member of the Defence Committee and digital policy spokesperson for the CDU/CSU parliamentary group.

Dr. Reinhard Brandl is a member of the CSU party executive committee. He is also chairman of the supervisory board of Artificial Intelligence Network Ingolstadt (AININ) and chairman of the CSU's working group on network policy (CSUnet). In addition, he is vice president of the Society for Security Policy (GSP).

Before joining parliament, Dr. Brandl studied industrial engineering in Karlsruhe and Grenoble. In 2007, he received his doctorate from the Faculty of Computer Science at the Technical University of Munich. Most recently, he worked as a consultant at the Boston Consulting Group in Munich.

Dr. Reinhard Brandl is an appointed member of the Diocesan Council of Catholics in the Diocese of Eichstätt.
